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Course Outline

Module 1: Classification References Review

- Review the four primary OPM classification references (Introduction to Classification Standards, Classifier's Handbook, Handbook of Occupational Groups and Families, Digest)
- Understand how to use The Classifier's Handbook and Digest of Decisions
- Identify applicable reference sections for complex classification scenarios

Module 2: Advanced Techniques in Classification

- Apply advanced techniques for classifying mixed grade and mixed series positions
- Evaluate positions that exceed standard factor levels using extrapolation and cross-series comparison
- Classify leaders, supervisors, and managers using the GSSG and Leader Guides
- Complete full classification projects and defend decisions using FES evaluation forms

Module 3: Advising Management on Position Classification and Organizational Design

- Shift from compliance to a consulting role in HR classification work
- Apply position management principles for efficient and effective organizational design
- Develop skills in organizational consulting, communication, and influence without authority
- Practice designing organizations and presenting recommendations to management in a capstone exercise
