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Course Outline

Module 1: Introduction to Federal Benefits

Introduce the two major federal retirement systems: Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS) & Federal Employees Retirement System (FERS)

Module 2: Retirement Eligibility

- Identify the types of retirements available under CSRS and FERS
- Review Age and years of service requirement
- Determine when employees are eligible to retire under the appropriate retirement system (CSRS or FERS)

Module 3: Social Security Benefits and Medicare Overview

- Identify the components of the Social Security benefits program
- Explain the eligibility requirements to receive Social Security retirement benefits and family benefits
- Describe how the SS benefit is computed
- Explain how SS retirement benefits and family benefits coordinate with CSRS and FERS retirement benefits
- Identify components of the Medicare program
