### Module 1: The Mandate for Timeliness

- Understand the impact of the information age on audit expectations
- Define audit cycle time and its effect on audit value and efficiency
- Identify causes and consequences of long audit cycle times
- Examine client demands for faster audit results

### Module 2: Assessing Conditions for Quick Response Audits

- Recognize when QRAs are appropriate and effective
- Assess risks and trade-offs in QRA engagements
- Identify factors that support or hinder quick responses
- Distinguish between audit, QRA, and consulting engagements

- Adapt objectives based on finding elements (condition, cause, effect, recommendations)

- Understand how scope correlates with objectives
- Limit scope by time, location, transactions, and personnel
- Accommodate resource and access constraints in design
- Apply targeted sampling and objective refinement

- Review GAGAS standards supporting QRAs
- Ensure independence, professional judgment, and competence
- Apply appropriate planning, supervision, evidence, and documentation standards

- Use GAGAS conceptual framework for non-audit services and independence
